



"Ocean Study 1" and "Incoming Storm" are included in the paintings I currently have available at Kaleidoscope.



50 Contemporary Women Artists, edited by John Gosslee and Heather Zises.

Reference the book description at www.amazon.com, this book features women artists and architects who have made significant and groundbreaking contributions to contemporary art. It is an international cross-section of living women artists—from emerging to established—who address critical, social, environmental, psychological, historical, and social issues through their art.

John Gosslee is the editor-in-chief of New York City based art magazine Quiet Lunch, runs PANK and Fjords Review, and his poetry is widely published. Heather Zises is an independent curator and Founder of (READ)art, a curatorial platform for contemporary art and culture. Having launched her career at Pace Gallery and Phillips, her research interests embrace feminist and identity-based practices. She is also one of the founders of Ninth Street Collective, a group of art administrators, gallerists, curators, writers and critics who want to help artists succeed.

50 Contemporary Women Artists gives a brief one page overview about the artist, followed by 4-6 pages showing their art. I am really looking forward to spending some time with this book getting to know these artists' creations.

I very much enjoyed **Ninth Street Women** by Mary Gabriel, a book about the art and artists of modern art leading up to and following World War II, with an eye to the personal and professional lives of five women involved in the movement: Lee Krasner, Elaine deKooning, Grace Hartigan, Joan Mitchell, and Helen Frankenthaler (see my July 2019 newsletter: https://docs.google.com/document/d/1GHWKbQvMUmFaGoAPd7L4wnRM9j RYa9JZzCiyVQepo4/edit
