#### **XENIA HARTOK**

Xenia Hartok's artistic practice consists primarily of figurative portraits and still lives. She investigates the idea of the modern woman, her appearance, tokens and feelings in a society that promotes very specific iconographies and lifestyles, accentuated or caricaturized by social media. Her series of paintings, collages and drawings present artificial reconstructions of the real world on flat backgrounds, filled with synthetic colors, unnatural perspectives and scales, as to almost replicated – with a much more labour intensive work – the wide spread, cheeky mise en scène of photoshop and programs of digital manipulation.

Xenia also shows a fascination for different cultures in her work. She is interested in identifying the myths that will be appropriated by a widely announced mediatic new world. In so doing, she appropriates symbols and stories from various cultural registers that relate to her own multicultural background. Xenia's paintings can unfold into spatial installations. Through her expanded form of painting, she solicits the performative character of her work. Xenia is also involved in multicultural art collectives
