In 1987 an idea was born. It would be in the community's interest to save the old school building and convert it into a cultural and art centre. The Old School House Arts Centre was the first art gallery in B.C. to be awarded charity status, and money was raised by the first Board of Directors, Bob Nichol, Al Grier and many others. The restoration of the building began in July. The job was completed by many weekend volunteer labourers, and The Old School House Centre for the Arts was opened on February 27, 1988. The opening ribbon was cut by Art Skipsey, the mayor of Qualicum Beach at that time. Tom McIver, the project restoration manager, described the project in this way: "It was symbolic of volunteer effort. It was a community effort in the tradition of our forefathers. We did it ourselves, and that's why it means so much."

In 2006 over 35,000 people visited The Old School House Arts Centre. In the same period over 500 students (ranging in age from 4 to 84) registered in workshops, classes and day camps. Over 150 artisans enjoyed a venue for showcasing and selling their work, 30 concerts were presented throughout the year with a participation of over 100 musicians and an average attendance of 80. TOSH has 425 members and 100 volunteers.

The 14th annual Grand Prix d'Art was held on July 28, 2007. Forty artists from Vancouver Island as well as the greater Vancouver area left their studios to converge in Qualicum Beach for a day of painting "en plein air". The Grand Prix d'Art is, indeed, a "race". Competing artists must complete a work of art in the space of three hours. Each artist is assigned a zone in the picturesque town of Qualicum Beach by lottery. The work must represent or be inspired by some thing or person that is visible from the assigned location. The artist must leave the finished work in presentation condition, titled and priced for sale no later than one hour after completion. A panel of three judges then determines the winners of the contest. The 2007 Judges were Dan Gray (the 2006 Grand Prix d'Art winner) and artists John Barton and Sally Laidlaw.
