


Interstitial

Interstitial refers to a place between moments. In this work I want to show the starts and stops by creating a circular neckpiece reflecting a cycle.

Counterclockwise the bottom right starts with an arrow leading the viewer to the top where there is a tipping point, and then coming around to the bottom a crescendo of interconnected, volumetric Möbius strips that cycle back to the origin. The Möbius strips are non-orientable and therefore have one side, illustrating an additional layer to the cyclical aspect of the piece.
