The Old School House Art Centre (TOSH) was established in 1987 to encourage community members as well as tourists to participate in cultural activities. TOSH is open year round and offers diverse programming (education, exhibitions and music).

TOSH's art classes provide students with the opportunity to learn new skills, maintain an active and participatory lifestyle and socialize. The Kids' Summer Program at TOSH offers parents and children an affordable and high quality option for summer child care/cultural activities.

The Community Art Exhibition Program is designed to provide a venue for local residents and visitors to learn, appreciate and purchase Vancouver Island original works of art. It highlights West Coast culture and promotes the value of art to individuals of all ages. It also provides amateur and professional artists and craftspeople the opportunity to develop awareness of and promote revenue from their respective arts, crafts and guilds. TOSH offers monthly and/or bi-monthly exhibitions in three galleries, totaling at least 36 exhibitions annually.

The Music Program consists of the Music On Sunday Concert Series and the Harvest of Music annual festival event. The finest professional musicians from B.C. and beyond are scheduled to perform throughout the year. An eclectic variety of concerts is offered in order to appeal to diverse musical interests. Harvest of Music concerts and workshops are held in our main gallery, in elementary, middle and secondary schools and in senior citizens' residential facilities.

The Old School House Arts Centre is a tourist attraction that generates revenue for the community and contributes to a positive impression of BC communities. Approximately 35,000 visitors attend our programs and exhibits annually. TOSH is proud to showcase the talent and culture of Vancouver Island, British Columbia.

Community commitment and support is demonstrated by the extent of volunteerism, corporate and/or individual financial contributions and volume of visitors who participate. Over 100 volunteers actively contribute to and participate in the ongoing success of TOSH.

All TOSH funds are raised through the many volunteer-based activities in combination with sponsorship donations from local businesses as "Partners In Art" and private individuals. Contributions and donations in support of our diverse activities and initiatives are always appreciated and qualify for tax receipts.

This calendar resembles coffee table books about Canada, Australia, Hawaii, Japan, etc. that offer multiple photographic impressions recorded on a single day. The Old School House Arts Centre (TOSH) chose the Summer Solstice, June 21, 2011 for the day on which the photographs would be taken. As the first day of summer it was a significant day, and, yet, as another Tuesday in beautiful Qualicum Beach it was not a particularly significant day.

We asked a wide range of photographers--from well-known artists to hobbyists--to submit their top photos. Invitations were sent to Chris Carter, Paul Kyba, Don Emerson, Rick Marotz, Wayne Buhr, Dave Graham, Brian Argyle, Lynn Bieber-Weir, members of the Oceanside Photographers Club, members of the Probus Club, student Geoffrey Campbell as well as all of the members of TOSH. Most of the images submitted have been used for this calendar, and all of the photographs will be exhibited at The Old School House Arts Centre from November 5 to 24, 2011.

Qualicum Beach is located on the east coast of Vancouver Island and boasts spectacular sandy beaches, coastal mountain vistas, and lush, temperate forests. Bordered to the east by the Salish Sea, Qualicum Beach also offers every watersport imaginable. The name "Qualicum" comes from a Pentlatch language term that means *where the dog salmon (or chum salmon) run*. Qualicum Beach was officially incorporated as a village on May 5, 1942, and was changed to town status on January 7, 1983. It is a favoured retirement and golfing community and has a Canada-wide reputation for its dynamic arts and cultural scene.

2012 is a year of special celebration for our community. The Town will celebrate 70 years of incorporation, The Old School House Arts Centre will celebrate 25 years of bringing the best of the arts to the mid-island region and the school house building that is home to the Arts Centre will be 100 years old.
