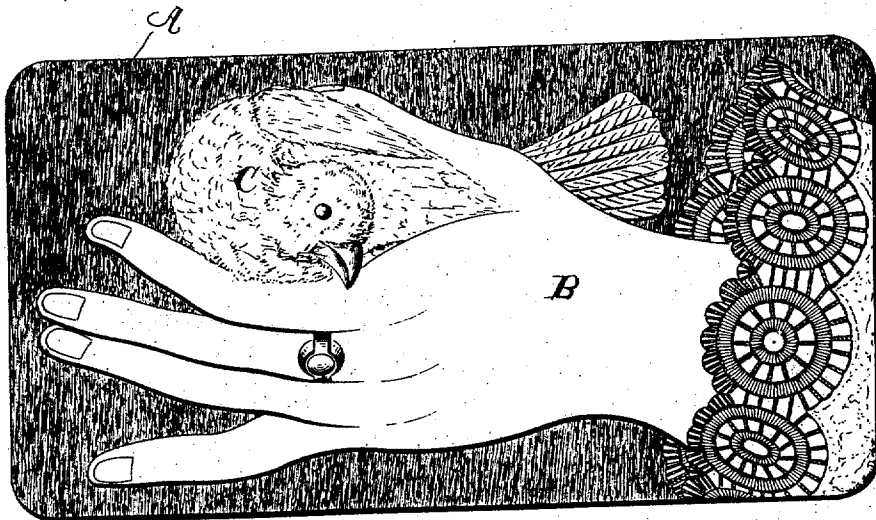

DESIGN FOR A DISH-COVER.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 19,283, dated August 27, 1889.

Application filed July 29, 1889. Serial No. 319,089. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, THOMAS B. ATTERBURY, a citizen of the United States, residing at Pittsburg, in the county of Allegheny and State of Pennsylvania, have invented and produced a new and original Design for Dish-Covers; and I do hereby declare the following to be a full, clear, and exact description of the same, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing I have shown a top or plan view of a dish-cover having the configuration of a hand placed partly over a bird. The cover, as shown in the accompanying illustration, has the appearance of a slab or plinth, which is of rectangular form with the corners slightly rounded, over which the hand extends. The hand represents that of a lady, provided with a ring and having the end of a sleeve in imitation of lace formed over the wrist portion of the arm. The hand rests over a bird, which it lightly incloses, giving it the appearance of just having reached out and secured the bird.

Referring to the drawing by letter, A indicates the oblong plinth or cover proper having the figure of a hand extending on top of the same. The hand B is provided with a ring, and has formed between the thumb and index-finger the bird C, said bird extending up above the hand and has its head turned toward the hand in the attitude of picking the index-finger.

What I claim is—

The design for a dish-cover, the same consisting of a rectangular slab with slightly-rounded corners having the configuration of a hand holding a bird between the index-finger and the thumb extending over the same, substantially as shown.
